

Libby: Download ebooks and audiobooks to your mobile device



What You Need:

- An Apple, Android or Windows operated phone or tablet
- An active Brooklyn Public Library account

What You Can Download:

- eBooks
- Audiobooks
- Send books to Amazon for Kindle downloads

Instructions:

1. Install the Libby app from your device's app store: Apple App Store, Google Play, Windows Store
2. Open Libby and select "Find My Library" to add Brooklyn Public Library. You can search by library name, city, or zip code.
3. Browse* your library's collection and borrow a title. When prompted, sign in with a valid library card.
4. Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** and download to the app automatically when you're connected to Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.
5. From your **Shelf**, you can:
 - Tap **Open book** or **Open audiobook** to start reading or listening to a title.
 - Tap the cover image, then **Send to Device** to send a book to Kindle.
6. Select **Library** at the bottom of the screen to continue browsing for titles.

* You may also search, borrow, or place a hold on eBooks through the main library catalog at borrow.bklynlibrary.org

What else can you do?

- Browse titles available from Overdrive
- Read and listen to downloaded books
- Renew titles and add holds

Your eAccount:

- You can borrow up to 15 downloadable titles combined (across Overdrive & Libby combined)
- You can place up to 10 holds on downloadable titles at a time
- You can choose your default lending periods under your account settings, from 7 days to 21 days. You don't have to return them – they automatically expire at the end of the loan period. No overdue fees!
