

You're in luck! Brooklyn Public Library **Book World** is a new children's video series where you can join us for wacky adventures at the library and discover a fun-filled world of learning, music, and books, books, books! For kids ages 2-7 and their grownups, who will discover how to encourage early literacy and make learning a joy!

There are 2 segments you could be featured in (all ages are welcome!):

Shine Time – highlights photos and videos (30 seconds or less) of you and/or your family. The current topic is "everyday science". We want photos and videos of you doing anything that relates to STEM. Examples include building things, observing animals and nature, doing home experiments (with supervision), noticing and playing with shapes, and using tools like rulers and magnifying glasses. Science is everywhere!

Check It Out – children share short video reviews of books. You will send in a video (30 seconds or less) with your child introducing themselves and telling us about a book they love. Make sure to let us know that your child would like to be considered for "Check It Out." We will contact you with your title and more details if they are chosen for the segment.

Email your submissions and questions to <u>bookworld@bklynlibrary.org</u>. If chosen to be on the show, you will be emailed a photo/video release form to complete for each of the people featured in your submission.

By submitting video footage and photos to Brooklyn Public Library for use in Book World, you understand that your child's video image and photo may be used by BPL in the creation of Book World episodes and videos. You also grant permission to Brooklyn Public Library and consent to your child's likeness and video images being used by Brooklyn Public Library on the Internet, in social media and in creation of the Book World web series. In addition, you are representing that you have the authority to release video images of this child and that you are the parent or legal guardian of this child.
